

The Setup:

EcoFactor analyzed 40 DR events across the country during the summer of 2011 comprising of approx. 3200 DR event location/days

Objectives:

Does advanced notification to the homeowner impact yield?

Does optimized pre-cool impact yield?

Equipment:

Two-way communicating thermostat

Service:

EcoFactor DR over IP SaaS Solution





Notifications

The data was compiled for similar outdoor temperature days

We created 4 scenarios:

No advanced notification, No optimized pre-cool No advanced notification, with optimized pre-cool With advanced notification, No optimized pre-cool With advanced notification, with optimized pre-cool





Summary:

Advanced notification:


Twice as likely to opt out of a DR event
Opt outs are late in the DR event
Most likely discomfort induced

No notification:

Lower aggregated opts outs

Come early and heavy

Of those that opted out, when did they do it...







Summary:

At the end of the day:


No Notification =

Early opt-outs = Lower overall yield

Notification =

Later opt-outs = Higher overall yield

Notification = a "bonus" 12.5% reduction in runtime








But what about precool?

Optimized precool provides a "bonus" 26% reduction in runtime as compared to a traditional 4 degree bump
